



Teaching Greek as a Second/Foreign Language

Introduction

The Program "Teaching of Modern Greek Language" is addressed to non-native students and working immigrants in Greece, with the aim of both developing their language skills and preparing them for Greek language proficiency exams. The Program covers three levels of language training (A1-A2, B1, B2), with 90 teaching hours for each level. The purpose of the Program is to enhance language skills in the Greek language. Participants will prepare for language proficiency exams, gain knowledge of Greek culture, and strengthen their professional and academic capabilities.

Upon completion of the Program, the following are pursued:

- Development of comprehension and communication skills in the Greek language.
- Preparation for language proficiency exams from level A1 to B2.
- Integration into Greek culture through cultural activities.
- Enhancement of professional and academic skills.
- Improvement of confidence in communication.

The Program is implemented exclusively **face-to-face** in a classroom at the University of Piraeus. Attendance is taken during lectures, and educational material covering all thematic units of the educational program is provided. Successful completion of the Program requires attendance of all teaching units, successful examination on the Program material, and full payment of the tuition fees. Furthermore, the total number of absences may not exceed 10% of the scheduled training hours.
